It's got gentle coconut and corn-derived cleansers and keratin-based strengtheners, but as the suds build, the only thing you'll likely notice is the woody, citrus-tinged fragrance. ## INEXPENSIVE FOR NORMAL HAIR Pantene Pro-V Daily Moisture Renewal

We've been known to alternate our pricey shampoo-and-conditioner combo with a great drugstore pairing, but this set is so good, you may just want to commit. The cleanser, says

N.Y.C. stylist Lacy Redway, won't dry out color- or chemically treated hair. Redway also loves how the conditioner moisturizes without making hair greasy. ## FOR DRY HAIR Kérastase Nutritive Bain Satin I/Lait Vital

Your strands are rough and dry, but your roots seem to collect oil faster than a Bounty sheet. Sound familiar? If so, this super-hydrating pair could be your winning compromise. Packed with amino acids, they'll keep strands

clean and strong without robbing them of moisture. "It's like instant gratification in a bottle," raves N.Y.C. stylist Chris Lospalluto, who works with Lana Del Rey. ## FOR FRIZZY HAIR Living Proof No Frizz

These humidity blockers can help fend off frizz right out of the shower—before you've loaded up on serums and smoothing spritzers. And unlike some silicone-based tamers, "the formulas won't build up and leave a residue," says Lospalluto. To all of you fine-haired friends, fear not: The word

## FOR CURLY HAIR DevaCurl No-Poo

Whether you consider your curls practically self-sufficient or somewhat high-maintenance, this all-in-one cleanser and conditioner can make coaxing them to bendy perfection so much easier. Just massage in the non-lathering formula, then rinse; the

sulfate- and silicone-free product cleanses and hydrates (with grape-seed and peppermint oils) without riling up cuticles. "It doesn't strip natural oils from the hair, making strands less likely to frizz," says L.A. stylist Christophe Saluzzo, who works with Connie Britton and Kate Walsh. ## FOR BRITTLE HAIR Carol's Daughter Monoi

N.Y.C. stylist Chuck Amos is most convincing about the strand-formative powers of this shampoo and conditioner when he talks about the strengthening miracles they've performed on one of his VIP clients: his mom. "She had so much breakage before

## FOR FINE HAIR Oribe Magnificent Volume

While the sulfate-free shampoo and conditioner do wonders to beef up strands, they won't make them straw-like in the process (a danger with volumizing cleansers, in particular). "If a client is looking

for body, I always prep with these before a blowout," says

## FOR COLOR-TREATED HAIR Oribe Beautiful Color

Just like you wouldn't throw your pleated midskirt into the spin cycle, you'd never shampoo pricey highlights with anything but a color-preserving

shampoo. (Right?) The only problem is, brands that score well on the color-preservation meter might sometimes get lower marks in other areas, like cleansing or strengthening. Not with this luxe pair: The formulas fight fading with edelweiss extract and battle oxidation with watermelon extract, they wash clean away, and "when you rinse these out, the hair doesn't feel brittle—it feels flexible and healthy," Amos says. \$42/\$44; [oribe.com](http://oribe.com).
